Greg manages the relationships within the WTCA organization and its partners, as well as provides oversight and leadership for the organization as a whole. Previously serving as the Attorney General for Indiana from 2009 through 2017 with Governors Mitch Daniels and Mike Pence, Greg served the well-being and privacy of the people of Indiana by focusing on consumer protection, public health, and public safety initiatives. Among his many roles, he served as the liaison for the Attorney General to the United States Trade Representative. Additionally, as the Attorney General of Indiana, Greg led many of the AG's efforts in creating bipartisan relationships with his state counterparts in Mexico. His partnerships with state and federal agencies in Mexico allowed for binational collaborations to address and combat transnational organized criminal activities.

Prior to his role as Attorney General, Greg served ten years as an executive assistant for Dan Quayle – first in Senator Quayle's U.S. Senate Office, and then in the Office of Vice President of the United States. Additionally, Greg was in private practice for 10 years. In his practice, Greg led WTC initiatives to import technology for Indiana companies, developed international trade missions for Indiana businesses, and provided the legal work required for international business deals. Greg attended both Purdue and Indiana University and earned his law degree from IU Maurer School of Law in 1982.
